WHY WE DO WHAT WE DO



According to the CDC, as of 2014, an average of 17,656 preborn children have been aborted each year in Tennessee alone since Roe v Wade in 1973. A little over 48 lives were lost per day.

While abortion has been framed as a "woman's choice", the truth is that most abortions are "chosen" by women who feel trapped, lonely, desperate - believing they have no choice.

CareNet Pregnancy Medical Center was founded in 1993 to give women life-affirming alternatives to abortion; alternatives that would provide loving support and comprehensive information to help them and their families make informed choices.

While CareNet's work is focused on sharing the Gospel and saving the lives of unborn children, we know that victory lies not only in choosing life for their children but giving those children and their families' abundant life. We also focus on strengthening families through marriage, parenting, adoption, and other life-affirming alternatives to abortion. The alternatives honor God's design for family life and Christ's desire that we all have abundant life.



"I learned a lot today, but I guess the most important was I have so many people behind me to support me."







Jess* was a client we recently had the pleasure of meeting at CareNet. She came to the center seeking a pregnancy test and ultrasound. She was undecided about her intentions with the pregnancy and wanted to explore all her options. She had recently finished college and was getting ready to take her final test for certification. She and the father of the baby were talking about marriage but wanted to finish school and get jobs. She was feeling overwhelmed and confused.

Jess shared that the father of the baby was her first and only partner and that she knew she should have been abstinent, but things just happened. She shared that she lived with her parents and did not want them to know until she decided what to do. She made an appointment for an ultrasound and both she and the father of the baby came to the appointment. The father of the baby was very curious and serious and asked lots of questions during the ultrasound. Jess stated she was dreading telling her parents and family.

She left the ultrasound appointment still undecided. The timing of the pregnancy wasn't fitting in her schedule. A follow-up call was made by our nurse a few weeks later. The client indicated she had told her parents about the pregnancy and said, "it was rocky, but we are taking it day by day." She shared that she and the father of the baby were "doing well" and plan to "keep the baby."

So thankful CareNet Staff was able to meet with her to assure her of God's love for her and to be able to provide information and services that allowed Jess to make an informed decision regarding her pregnancy.
